The Performer – with TJUPURRU

Queensland based international performer Adrian Fabila Tjupurrula – aka- **Tjupurru**, is a descendant of the **Djabera Djabera Tribe** of the **Western Australian Kimberlies**. A very skilled and gifted musician, Tjupurru has toured extensively nationally and internationally doing performances and school workshops since 2006 and collaborated with some of the biggest names in the music industry across New Zealand, New Caledonia, Japan, the USA and Canada. He has performed at The Opera House, Jazz in the Domain, Winter Olympic Games and Woodford Folk Festival, just to name a few.

The Performance

Tjupurru plays the **DIDJERIBONE** which is an Australian Made and designed instrument fusing the elements of the didgeridoo and trombone. Tjupurru shares his inspiring personal journey, the history of his culture and the expressions of Aboriginal art and music, enriching a deeper understanding of Indigenous culture.

Tjupurru captivates students with his extraordinary live interactive performance of the "**Didjeribone Show**". He interacts with them using his **Face Bass** – a unique seismic sensor, to create ingenious and innovative songs and sound-scapes that blend elements of the traditional with contemporary, using a combination of masterful sequencing and sampling **technologies** along with **traditional** instruments and live organic sounds.

Teachers and students are introduced to amazing modern music technologies whilst they are delighted in the opportunity to hear instant results of their shared music making abilities.
